Since 1994, EU staff and ministry officials in Europe who work closely with the institutions of the European Union have been invited to Germany by the Federal Foreign Office and the Goethe-Institut on the Europanetzwerk Deutsch programme.

### European network

Tailored specifically to the fields of work and language proficiency levels of the course participants, the four- to nine-day courses offer an intensive German language course and provide an opportunity to forge professional contacts with peers in German ministries and institutions.

All courses are closely related to European issues. Some courses feature an additional focus, e.g. the environment, economy or digitization.
